## ACTION TO KEEP COLLIER ROW CLEAN

Whilst out meeting residents in the Thameshill and Oaks Avenue area, Cllr. Jason Frost, Cllr. Dilip Patel and Cllr. Carol Smith were informed about an increase in the amount of dog mess that had been accumulating in and around the junctions at each end of Oaks Avenue. This was in addition to the build-up of litter at these same locations. In response your Collier Row & Mawneys Conservative Action Team have put up some large poster size notices on the lamp columns close to these junctions urging local dog owners to make sure they clear up after their pets and/or not to discard the bags once they have done so. If your area has become a hot-spot for dog fouling please let your Councillors know and we will come and put a poster up in an effort to deter this behaviour in future.

## PLAGUE OF SHOPPING TROLLEES

It has come to our attention that shopping trolleys are regularly being taken off the premises of local supermarkets and then causally discarded at locations across the area. Whilst this activity may seem relatively harmless, the act of removing a branded shopping trolley off the premises of a supermarket actually qualifies as theft. The further act of discarding the trolley on the public highway constitutes an act of fly-tipping; which is an enforceable offence. We ask all residents to refrain from engaging in such activity. Please notify us right away if you spot it happening.



## PARKING AT WHITE HART LANE SHOPPING PARADE

The Collier Row & Mawneys Team have recently been contacted by residents in and around the shopping parade in White Hart Lane to complain about the long-stay usage of the parking bays meant to service the shops. Is this a problem experienced by residents more widely? Many of the smaller parades around the Borough now have Pay & Display parking restrictions in force in order to discourage long-stay parking at these locations during business hours. Is this something that residents and businesses think will help to ease the problem at this location? ### HOG HILL ROAD

Whilst out driving, Cllr. Dilip Patel noticed that the lamp column in Hog Hill Road, opposite the junction of Hamlet Road, had been damaged and was now badly leaning over. This has now been reported for action to the Council's lighting contractor, Volkens.



### DAMAGED KERBSTONES
